In consideration of being permitted to ride in a Parlier Police vehicle the undersigned assumes all risks of damage or loss either to person or property from all and every cause, including negligence, violation of the law, or willful misconduct on the part of the Parlier Police Department, its officers, employees or agents during such ride or as incident thereto, or in connection therewith, it being the understanding that the City of Parlier, the Parlier Police Department, its officers, employees or agents incur no liability or obligation to the undersigned, his/her heirs, successors or assigns other than to permit him/her to ride in such vehicle at such a time as may be mutually agreed upon. This waiver applies to each and every ride, which the undersigned may take in a Parlier Police vehicle.

Witness in criminal court proceedings:

All persons riding in department vehicles will as required, be included by name in official reports. These reports may cause the rider to be subpoenaed to court as a witness.

Records check:

The police department will make a criminal history records check on all applicants for the ride-along program before they are allowed to ride in police vehicles.

CONDITIONS FOR RIDE-ALONG

Ride-Along attire and personal items

- A. All participants shall dress appropriately for the ride-along.
- B. The following items shall not be worn during ride-along activities:
 - 1. Sandals or any other type of shoe, which does not cover the entire foot.
 - 2. Short pants.
 - 3. Halter-top.
 - 4. Jeans with holes or in poor condition.
 - 5. Any other clothing, which is deemed inappropriate by the Watch Commander.
- C. Cameras, tape recorders, or any other type of recording devices, manual or electric, are
Not permitted without prior approval of the Chief of Police.

Ride-Along Conduct and Rules

- A. All approved participants must report to the Police Department fifteen (15) minutes prior to the beginning of the assigned shift. Unless prior arrangements are approved, the watch Commander will be assigned.
- B. Passengers are forbidden from bringing weapons of any type during the ride-along.
 - 1. The ride-along passenger shall not be allowed access to any of the weapons in the patrol unit or within the control of the officer.
 - 2. Sworn law enforcement officials, after proof of identification, may carry weapons that have been approved by their respective department's policies.
- C. Ride-along participants will be under the control and supervision of the officer to whom they are assigned.
- D. Ride-along participation must not interfere or participate in any way with an officer who is handling a police incident, unless the officer specifically requests assistance.

Termination of Ride-Long

- A. A ride-along may be cancelled any time during the ride by the:
 - 1. Officer.
 - 2. Watch Commander.
 - 3. Ride-along passenger.
