Did You Know?

- ⇒ Did you know an older model Honda is the car of choice stolen by thieves in the City of Parlier?
 - The Police Department recommends car owners use a steering wheel lock such as a club. Using a club alerts the thief that your car will be difficult to steal. If you use a club correctly, the thief is more likely to go to the next car that doesn't have a club.
- ⇒ Did you know if you leave a disabled car on the street, driveway or front lawn for a long period of time, you can receive a citation and your car can be towed away?
 - The violation is under the City of Parlier's Municipal Code 10.60.010 & 10.36.030 (vehicle nuisance ordinance). In an effort to improve the City's image, we are enforcing the Vehicle Nuisance Ordinance, so we appreciate your support in not storing disabled cars in front of your property. - ⇒ Did you know under Business and Professions code 22435.2 (a-f), it is a misdemeanor to remove shopping carts from business properties?
