STATEMENT ON RULES OF DECORUM AND ENFORCEMENT

The Brown Act provides that members of the public have a right to attend public meetings, to provide public comment on action items and under the public forum section of the agenda, and to criticize the policies, procedures, or services of the city or of the acts or omissions of the city council. The Brown Act also provides that eh City Council has the right to exclude all persons who willfully cause a disruption of a meeting so that it cannot be conducted in an orderly fashion.

During a meeting of the Parlier City Council, there is a need for civility and expedition in the carrying out of public business in order to ensure that the public has a full opportunity to be heard and that the Council has an opportunity to conduct business in an orderly manner. The following is provided to place everyone on notice of the rules of decorum and enforcement.

GENERAL RULES OF DECORUM

While any meeting of the City Council is in session, the following rules of decorum shall be observed:

- 1. All remarks shall be addressed to the City Council as a whole and not to any single member, unless in response to a question from a member of the City Council.
- 2. A person who addresses the City Council under public comment for a specific agenda item or under the Public Forum section of the agenda may not engage in speech or conduct (I) which is likely to provoke others to violent or riotous behavior, (ii) which disturbs the peace of the meeting by loud and unreasonable noise, (iii) which is irrelevant or repetitive, or (iv) which disrupts, disturbs, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of any City Council meeting.
- 3. A person, other than members of the Council and the person, who has the floor, shall not be permitted to enter into the discussion unless requested by the Mayor to speak.
- 4. Members of the City Council may not interrupt a person who has the floor and is making public comments. Members of the City Council shall wait until a person completes his or her public comments before asking questions or commenting. The Mayor shall then ask Council members if they have comments or questions.
- 5. No person in the audience at a Council meeting shall engage in disorderly or boisterous conduct, including the utterance of loud, threatening or abusive language, whistling, stamping of feet or other acts which disturb, disrupt or otherwise impeded the orderly conduct of any Council meeting.

Members of the City Council shall wait until a person completes his or her public comments before asking questions or commenting. The Mayor shall then ask Council members if they have comments or questions.
- 5. No person in the audience at a Council meeting shall engage in disorderly or boisterous conduct, including the utterance of loud, threatening or abusive language, whist ling, stamping offeet or other acts which disturb, disrupt or otherwise impeded the orderly conduct of any Council meeting.

Amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement for the Southeast regional solid waste commission.

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

- 1. Adopt by resolution the amended and superseded Joint Powers Agreement
- 2. Approve and authorize the City Manager of the Parlier to execute the amended and superseded Joint Powers Agreement with the County of Fresno and the Cities of Fowler, Kingsburg, Orange Cove, Reedley, Sanger and Selma to reflect current post-closure status of the Southeast Regional Solid Disposal Site

REPORT:

The current Joint Powers Agreement (JPA), which was last revised in 1988, is outdated as it reflects that the inactive Southeast Regional Disposal Site (SERDS) remains an operational solid waste disposal facility. The amended and superseded JPA reflects the current post-closure maintenance status of SERDS. It details post-closure maintenance funding consisting of the existing \$3.50 per ton surcharge and it incorporates the appropriate direction provided by the Southeast Regional Solid Waste Commission (Commission) Board in relation to the approved supplemental fees collected from each jurisdiction, which are to be approved annually by the Commission. The amended and superseded JPA will be adopted by resolution of all City Councils of each member jurisdiction and the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no increase in Net County Cost. The \$3.50 Surcharge fee assessed to landfilled tonnage generated within the SER area and paid by the jurisdiction or the contracted haulers funds the cost for ongoing administration of the SERDS JPA. Sufficient appropriations and estimated revenues are included in the Solid Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund (Fund 402). Additionally, the cost of the City of Parlier annual supplemental payment is included in the same fund budget (Fund code 402).

DISCUSSION:

The Cities of Fowler, Kingsburg, Selma, Orange Cove, Parlier, Reedley, and Sanger (Cities) and the County of Fresno (County) share ownership of the closed SERDS located at t12716 E. Dinuba, Selma, CA. A map depicting the SER area is attached as Exhibit A. In 1970, the seven Cities and the County executed a JPA to manage and to secure appropriate funding for the

operation of the SERDS. The JPA detailed ownership of the SERDS and it identified the County as the administrator of the agreement. The County established Enterprise Fund 0720 and Budget Unit 9020 to administer revenues and oversee expenses for the SERDS. The SERDS ceased to operate in 1990 and is currently in post-closure maintenance. The post-closure maintenance activities are funded by a \$3.50 per ton surcharge fee (Surcharge) applied to landfilled waste generated within the SER area. Post-closure maintenance will continue until SERDS is no longer considered by the State to pose a threat to public health and safety, and the environment. Postclosure requirements are set forth in regulations promulgated by the State Water Resources Control Board and CalRecycle in Title 27, Division 2, Chapter 3, Subchapter 5, Articles 1 and 2. California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), most notably Sections 20950 and 21100. In 1987, it was estimated that 138,800 tons of waste from the SER area would be subject to the Surcharge; however, since then the State has mandated recycling and diversion programs, which have significantly reduced the amount of waste generated within the SER area, which in turn has created a revenue shortfall. Additionally, the County has been diligent in reducing and/or eliminating expenditures, but is unable to match the revenue shortfall as most of the costs are directly related to post-closure compliance.

At the March 28, 2016 meeting, County staff informed the Commission that an evaluation of the financial data identified that beginning FY 2017-18, expenditures would exceed the SERDS fund cash reserves and Surcharge revenues collected. County staff provided a report that detailed the balance of funds, current and proposed expenditures, which quantified that the current funds and cash reserves will not be sufficient to continue to fund the closure, post-closure maintenance activities. County staff stated that additional funding would be needed, on an annual basis, from each of the JPA member jurisdictions to ensure on-going and future regulatory compliance.

County Staff provided copies of executed JPAs and noted to the Commission that the JPA specified ownership of SERDS and it stipulated a guaranteed amount of waste by jurisdiction to secure the funds needed to operate and maintain SERDS. The JPA also prescribed actions to be taken to address insufficient funds or a shortfall in revenues The Commission requested that County staff provide a comprehensive analysis of funding needed to continue to adhere to statemandated closure, post-closure regulations for SERDS. The proposed approach was to assess the amount of shortfall to be made up by each jurisdiction in accordance with the provisions of the JPA that specified the percentage of ownership and guaranteed tonnage delivery of each jurisdiction. At the June 27, 2016 Commission meeting, County staff provided the Commission members with a spreadsheet detailing the following information: Jurisdiction, Percentage of Share as identified in Exhibit B to the1988 JPA, and the anticipated funding needs for the four-year period beginning with FY 2017-18 through FY 2020-21. The Commission requested that County staff also develop a "blended" cost table that takes into account a portion of the SERDS ownership. This "blended" method places a larger liability on the County, as the County is the majority owner of SERDS. The Commission requested that prior to October 31, 2016, County staff issue correspondence to each jurisdiction apprising them of the SERDS financial forecast, and to coordinate with the Commission member representing each jurisdiction to facilitate presentation of the forecast to each of the respective jurisdictions' governing bodies.

At the January 23, 2017 Commission meeting, County staff reported that all member jurisdictions had been apprised of the SERDS Financial Forecast. Commission members present acknowledged a preference in using the "blended" method to determine cost apportionment. The Commission Chairman requested that an official vote be taken. The Commission members voted unanimously to implement the "blended" method, and directed County staff to present a report to the Board of Supervisors apprising them of the actions taken and authorized staff to prepare and

issue invoices to each respective jurisdiction utilizing the "blended" table, as identified in Attachment B of the JPA, prior to July of each year. Staff presented the item to the Board of Supervisors on April 4, 2017.

The amended JPA reflects the current post-closure maintenance status of SERDS, identifies ownership and cost apportionment, and it incorporates the Commission's direction regarding the supplemental funding by each jurisdiction, which shall be assessed in an amount to be revised annually, based upon post-closure maintenance activities conducted at SERDS.

WHEREAS, the California Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972, and the Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989, each have been enacted with the intent and purpose that local agencies develop a solid waste management master plan for each county including not less than a majority of the cities therein; and.

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the parties hereto jointly manage SERDS in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations and the provisions of the County's Integrated Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the JPA was amended and superseded in its entirety by Amended JPAs dated February 7, 1978, April 24,1984, September, 30, 1986 and October 25, 1988, respectively; and

WHEREAS, SERDS ceased operations on July 20, 1990, and the California Integrated Waste Management Board certified the Closure of SERDS on January 19, 2000; and

WHEREAS, SERDS ongoing post-closure maintenance is required by California 1 Code of Regulations Title 27, oversight of which is conducted by various regulatory 2 3 agencies; and WHEREAS, the County and the Cities desire to amend and supersede the 1988 4 JPA, to reflect the current post-closure status of SERDS and to establish and allocate 5 the proportionate respective shares of the cost of post-closure maintenance among 6 each of the Cities and the County; and 7 WHEREAS, each of the Cities' respective governing bodies previously has 8 adopted by Resolution, and pursuant thereto has executed, the Amended JPA which 9 shall become effective upon full execution by all parties; and 10 WHEREAS, the Cities and the County agree to continue to fund post-closure 11 maintenance of SERDS by means of the existing Southeast Regional solid waste 12 surcharge, in the amount of \$3.50 per ton of solid waste generated within the Southeast 13 Regional Area, as reflected in Attachment "A" of the Amended JPA, and by 14 supplemental funding from each jurisdiction as provided in Attachment "B" of the 15 Amended JPA and as approved annually by the Southeast Regional Solid Waste 16 Commission. 17 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the PARLIER hereby adopts the Amended JPA, which supersedes all prior amendments relating to 19 20 the subject matter hereof; and 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CITY MANAGER is hereby authorized 22 and empowered to execute said Amended JPA, which shall become effective upon 23 such execution. 24 III25 III

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AMENDED JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO AND THE CITIES OF SANGER, REEDLEY, SELMA, ORANGE COVE, KINGSBURG, FOWLER, AND PARLIER

This Amended Joint Powers Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this _______ day of _______, 2018, by and between the COUNTY OF FRESNO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "COUNTY", and the cities of SANGER, REEDLEY, SELMA, ORANGE COVE, KINGSBURG, FOWLER, and PARLIER, all municipal corporations within the COUNTY, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "CITIES."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties have heretofore entered into a Joint Powers Agreement ("Original JPA") dated May 18, 1970, for the operation of the Southeast Regional Disposal Site (hereinafter referred to as "SER"), as therein provided; and

WHEREAS, the SER ceased operations on July 20, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board certified the Closure of SER on January 19, 2000; and

WHEREAS, ongoing post-closure maintenance is required by California Code of Regulations Title 27 and various regulatory agencies; and

WHEREAS, the parties previously amended and superseded said Original JPA in its entirety by Amended JPAs dated February 7, 1978, April 24, 1984, September 30, 1986 and October 25, 1988, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend and supersede the most recently amended version of the JPA dated October 25, 1988.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Article I. NATURE AND AUTHORITY FOR AGREEMENT

Each of the parties to this Agreement is a public agency within the meaning of section 6500 of the Government Code of the State of California and the parties have in common the

legal power to acquire, develop, maintain, operate, dispose of and replace a solid waste disposal site, and any related solid waste processing facilities including the transfer station. In addition, the California Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972, and the Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989, each have been enacted with the intent and purpose that local agencies develop a solid waste management master plan for each county including not less than a majority of the cities therein. It is in the public interest that the parties hereto jointly manage the SER in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations and the provisions of the County's Integrated Waste Management Plan. The parties hereto have entered into this Agreement, as well as the Original JPA and all prior amendments thereto, pursuant to the joint operation of powers provisions of said Section 6500, et seq. of the Government Code of the State of California.

Article II. PURPOSE

The parties agree to fund the Post Closure maintenance of SER by means of an existing solid waste surcharge in the amount of \$3.50 per ton of solid waste generated within the Southeast Regional Area as indicated on Attachment "A" and by supplemental funding from each jurisdiction, as approved annually by the Commission that is identified in Article IV of this Agreement.

Article III. ADMINISTERING AGENCY

The COUNTY, by and through its Board of Supervisors and regular COUNTY departments, shall be the agency which administers this Agreement. In pursuance thereof, it shall possess the common power specified in this Agreement to contract services and acquire equipment needed to effect the ongoing post-closure maintenance of SER.

Article IV. COMMISSION

There shall be a Commission to be known as the Southeast Regional Solid Waste Commission. It shall consist of nine persons selected as follows: two members of the Board of Supervisors, and one Councilperson to be appointed from each of the Cities of Sanger, Reedley, Selma, Orange Cove, Kingsburg, Fowler, and Parlier. Each appointment may include an alternate member designated to serve in the absence of the principal appointee. An

alternate member may be an employee of the appointing agency. The Commission shall select a chairperson and vice-chairperson, each from a different agency, establish times for regular meetings, hold special meetings at the call of the chairperson or any four members, and shall conduct its proceedings according to Robert's Rules of Order as last revised. The vice-chairperson shall act in the absence of the chairperson. To constitute a quorum, there shall be no less than five members at a meeting. The passage of any motion shall require at least five affirmative votes. The County's Solid Waste Coordinator, as identified in the Fresno County Integrated Waste Management Plan, shall serve as Secretary of the Commission.

Article V. COMMISSION POWERS

The Commission shall have the power to make decisions that shall be binding on the administering agency and the parties hereto, subject to all limitations of law, on the following matters:

- A. Acquisition or lease of real or personal property to be used for waste processing, disposal, or the sale thereof. Such property shall be held in the name of the COUNTY for the benefit of the member agencies. The execution of this Agreement does not establish or convey any right or interest in any existing solid waste facilities or property presently owned by any party hereto.
- B. Establishment of fees to be charged for the use of any waste processing or disposal facilities administered under this JPA.
- C. Establishment of methods for resource recovery and the sale of products derived therefrom.
- D. Establishment of methods of capital financing of waste processing or disposal facilities including contracting with a member agency for use of financing powers of such agency.
- E. Determination as to whether grants shall be sought for a solid waste management project and approval of conditions, if any, for grant acceptance.
- F. Determination as to whether a waste processing facility shall be operated by a public or private entity and the establishment or approval of the terms and method

 of operation.

- G. Approval of contracts with public or private entities, including member agencies, for the ownership, financing, design, construction, operation, utilization, or acquisition of waste processing or disposal facilities including waste-to-energy facilities or transfer stations.
- H. Restriction of any member agency from the operation of any waste processing or disposal facility to be acquired or developed after the effective date of this Agreement.

Article VI. CONTRIBUTIONS OF PARTIES

- A. Each of the parties has agreed that its proportionate share of the cost for the ongoing post-closure maintenance of SER shall be and is hereby set, based on a blended calculation of ownership and population, as follows: County of Fresno, 45.3%; City of Sanger, 13.8%; City Reedley, 12.0%; City of Selma, 11.8%; City of Orange Cove, 4.7%; City of Kingsburg, 5.1%; City of Fowler, 3.0%; and City of Parlier, 4.4%.
- B. In January of each year, the Commission shall review the status and forecast of the SER operational funds. If the operational funding provided by the solid waste surcharge revenues of \$3.50 per ton is deemed insufficient by the Commission to fund the Post Closure maintenance of SER for the following Fiscal Year, the Commission shall direct the COUNTY to invoice each member agency based on their proportionate share of the total funds needed to ensure that the operational funding levels remain at a minimal but positive cash reserve level.
- C. SER shall be deemed to be equitably owned by the parties in proportion to their initial ownership contributions as follows: County of Fresno, 51%; City of Sanger, 13.3%; City Reedley, 10.7%; City of Selma, 10.4%; City of Orange Cove, 4.8%; City of Kingsburg, 4.3%; City of Fowler, 3.1%; and City of Parlier, 2.4%.

Article VII. MAINTENANCE OF SER

It is agreed that the COUNTY is authorized to and shall make all arrangements for the ongoing post-closure maintenance of SER either by Day Labor or Contract, and shall report to

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the Commission at least annually regarding the cost incurred therefor. The COUNTY also shall arrange for the planning and installation of any necessary physical features for SER such as, but not limited to, landscaping, fencing, water supply, and access roads, either by Day Labor or Contract, and subject to prior Commission approval.

Article VIII. FUNDS

All funds received from the parties pursuant to any provisions of this Agreement or from the solid waste surcharge shall be deposited with the COUNTY Auditor-Controller/Treasurer in the SER Enterprise Fund No. 0720, Subclass 15000, for the purpose of funding post-closure maintenance at SER as required by applicable laws and regulations, and such other post-closure activities as may be authorized by the Commission.

Article IX. INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE

Notwithstanding anything else to the contrary herein, the Commission shall indemnify. save harmless and defend all parties and their officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims for money or damages arising from personal injury or property damage, or public officials' errors and omissions, or any combination thereof in the performance of this Agreement. The COUNTY, as administering agency, shall procure and maintain insurance to this end in an amount and coverage equal to that maintained by COUNTY for its own purposes. The insurance shall name the parties, and their respective officers, agents, and employees as additional insureds. The cost of such insurance shall be an obligation of the Enterprise Fund. In the event funds in the Enterprise Fund are insufficient, the COUNTY may annually charge all parties their pro rata share of all or a portion of the cost of such coverage, including the cost of funding a self-insured retention fund using the same percentage as described in Article VI herein. Such insurance shall be primary, covering all parties jointly and severally, subject to the limits and all provisions, conditions, and exclusions contained within COUNTY's Certificate of Insurance and all related forms and policy documents governing such coverage, and there shall be no right to pro rata indemnification from the parties under the Joint Powers Provisions of the California Tort Claims Act. COUNTY expressly limits its liability to the other parties hereto to the extent of insurance afforded by the policies aforesaid and

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save except for such coverage, expressly disclaims any other indemnity or general liability protection.

DURATION OF AGREEMENT AND AMENDMENT Article X.

This Agreement shall continue until terminated in accordance with this Article. This Agreement shall be terminated at the written request of or withdrawal by the governing body of at least five members hereto and the COUNTY. It may be amended at any time, including the addition of new parties, by the unanimous consent of the governing bodies of all parties hereto. Upon termination of this Agreement, all obligations shall be disbursed to the parties hereto in proportion to their contribution.

SUPERSEDING AGREEMENT Article XI.

This Agreement, upon its execution by all of the parties hereto, shall supersede in its entirety the Original JPA dated May 18, 1970, the Amended JPA dated February 7, 1978, the Amended JPA dated April 24, 1984, the Amended JPA dated September 30, 1986, and the Amended JPA dated October 25, 1988 referred to above, and any other amendments thereto. Ownership, contributions, and other rights of all parties under the superseded JPA as previously amended remain in full force and effect, except as herein modified by this Agreement.

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IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto pursuant to the resolutions of their respective governing boards have caused this Amended Joint Powers Agreement to be executed as of the day and year first hereinabove written.

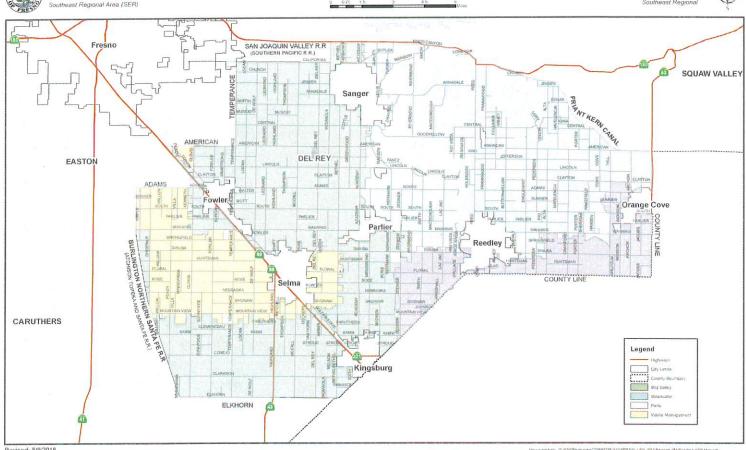

Measures K&L Voter Education and Public Outreach Contract Update

RECOMMENDATION:

Informational item only

BACKGROUND:

Measure K, a City of Parlier 4% utility user's tax, is on the November 6, 2018 ballot for voter approval.

On September 6, 2018 the City Manager reported on efforts begun by the previous City Manager and City Attorneys to solicit a public relations vendor for an immediate voter outreach and public education campaign to disseminate neutral information on this municipal ballot measure in time for the November 2018 election.

The ballot measure would raise funds to pay for the City's fire protection and emergency medical response services that are currently expected to cost over \$340,000 per year beginning with the current year, FY 2018-19.

The Council on September 6 authorized the City Manager to select a firm from invited respondent and enter into an Agreement for professional services with the sole firm that had provided a responsive proposal by the time of the Council meeting, with an agreement budget of \$30,000 from City funds. Activities were to be restricted to legally compliant informational activities that would promote voter awareness and public education but not advocate to support or oppose the measure.

As reported to the Council in September, the following professional service providers had been contacted by phone and by follow-up email to submit proposals:

- Rose Strategic Public Relations
- JP Marketing
- J. Peter DeYoung
- GlobalCommunicationsLLC

While all had initially confirmed interest in submitting proposals, the City's requirements (12,000 contacts within the 6-8 week period before November 6 including a combination of direct phone contacts plus door-to-door canvassing, in addition to yard signage and 4x8 signs) were beyond the capacity of any responding firms except one, given the limited budget of only \$30,000 and the extremely limited time frame.

In discussions with the Rose, JP, and DeYoung firms they focused on low-cost, low-impact activities such as website development, social media advertising, and radio. Only GlobalCommunicationsLLC was willing to take on a work order that required intensive grassroots activities and deliverables within the time frame. However, they also indicated that the City's work order would normally require a budget of \$36-40,000. In the end, they agreed to accept the contract and to take responsibility to donate at their own expense or otherwise secure outside financing for any additional costs using non-City funds if needed.

There is no legal or ethical bar to vendors such as any of the above accepting work from multiple campaigns or candidates during election season and it is common practice to do so. However, the City requested and the vendor agreed that no local Parlier candidates would be serviced by vendor staff who were working on the City contract. The vendor also agreed to make themselves available for additional unrelated assignments as needed as provided pricing for such potential other work in the contract agreement, such as mass flyer or newsletter distributions, translation services, printing, or graphic design not related to the Measure K & L campaign.

The principals of the vendor firm, Krystal Hernandez and Karina Vargas, are both university graduates in Communications from California State University Fresno and many of you are likely familiar with their previous work at Fresno EOC and the Parlier Post, respectively. At my suggestion they registered their enterprise with the California Secretary of State for business purposes (CA LLC Registration #201827410358) at their business mailing address, 4677 E Nevada Ave in Fresno, a property which according to County records is owned by an unrelated party. This business mailing address is consistent with the address provided on their IRS W-9 submitted to our finance department along with their initial invoices, and also with the business address on file with the IRS at the time of their receipt of a business EIN tax ID.

At the time of this writing, October 22, the firm has submitted a total of 2 invoices against the Measure K & L outreach contract, for agreed progress payments of \$10,000 each, with one more payment due upon completion of the project. In addition, the same firm was utilized for unrelated deliveries of emergency utility notices on two occasions (at half the price of the U.S. Postal Service for previous deliveries) for a total of \$2,140.

ACTIVITIES TO DATE

Here are the accomplishments of the public outreach and voter education campaign through Oct 22, 2018:

- 4,231 registered unique voters confirmed contacted
- 1,357 voters were not contactable by phone (840 wrong numbers, the rest disconnected)
- 2,400 residences were contacted by door-to-door canvass including the 1,357 without known phone numbers, 89 refused to speak at door, 130 voters had moved to new addresses, net 2,181 personal contacts
- 503 identified Yes's have been being targeted for focused attention schedule of 3-4 calls and 2-3 home visits to continue to provide information and confirm
- 6 FTE staff have been assigned plus 4 high school student volunteers
- Data cost ended up being above budget by \$1,700, difference was absorbed by the vendor
- 200 small yard signs were distributed to residences and businesses
- 20 4x8 large signs have been installed throughout the city
- The final two weeks are higher intensity activities including GOTV support (upon request of residents)

NOTES

City staff including City Manager, Deputy City Clerk, and City Attorney have responded in full to multiple public records requests in recent weeks from candidates, Councilmembers, and residents for background documents related to the vendor, contracting process, and payments made to date.

The following updates have been provided to the Council on October 18 and 29 and are being included in this report for completeness:

--The City is never legally allowed to use public funds for ballot advocacy of any kind related to these tax measures. Any printed materials, signage, and scripted or unscripted communications can only be for public outreach and voter education. This is why it was illegal to use City funds to say 'Vote Yes on

Measure K & L." The text of the collateral flyers and signs was carefully reviewed to remove all illegal advocacy language and only to make factual statements to educate the public regarding what the tax measure will pay for. Although the text layout was challenging, and the Spanish versions of the signs was even more unwieldy than the English versions, staff believes the graphic images are powerful and our priority was to comply with the law.

--City staff investigated a complaint we received from mayoral candidate and business owner Fernando Banuelos of the NUE P.A.T.H. at the registered business address 560 H St, Parlier, CA, alleging that the same volunteers or outreach workers were also distributing candidate flyers for Mayor Beltran. We found that this complaint was false and not substantiated in any way. City funds cannot be used to support a specific candidate or measure. However, as of the current date there has been no corroboration that any noncompliant activities have occurred any point related to the use of City funds to support any candidate's purchases or campaign workers and no comingling of any candidate's campaign workers or materials with the public outreach campaign has occurred at any point. We have requested that any interested parties who may have contrary evidence provide it to the City so that we can investigate immediately as we all take these legal obligations extremely seriously and we are all on the same page together on this in every respect.

--To date the public relations and outreach contractor has only received two progress payments of \$10,000 each from City funds for this contract. A second progress payment of \$10,000 is due at the end of the contract. This has been our agreed schedule with the vendor from the beginning and it has not changed at any point.

--This vendor's proposal was for \$36,000 in work and deliverables, of which only \$30,000 was to be contributed from the City. The other \$6,000 was offered to be covered by the vendor as an in-kind donation of work and materials to the Measure K & L campaign or else raised by them from private donations so that they do not necessarily eat that whole cost alone. However, in no case was the City expected nor obligated to pay more than \$30,000 and the \$6,000 difference was always agreed on all sides to be the sole responsibility of the contractor. The reason for the \$36,000 number is because the vendor did not believe that \$30,000 was sufficient to cover all of the activities that needed to happen during the short campaign timeframe, and was willing to donate or take responsibility to raise the difference. (This subset of private money or in-kind work also could potentially create some strategic legal flexibility if necessary which we would not otherwise have.)

--Although no person had come forward to the City with any direct complaints (we had only received second- and third-hand accounts of anonymous original sources as of the writing of this report). However, Mayor Pro Tem Escoto identified one specific person making the claim (although not by name, only by political office). Staff immediately on October 19 then sent a written request for a statement to that person, eventually inferred to be J.D. Garza the PUSD Board President, and at the same time sent a written request for a formal statement to Mr. Banuelos (see above). Mr. Garza responded directly and he did not substantiate any of the claims, including those made in his name by other people. Mr. Banuelos has not responded to the request at any point, nor to a follow-up request made to him on Oct 26. Both individuals were invited to also provide any documentation such as photos, names, times, and locations of incidents related to the concerns you wrote about, however none has been provided.

--As of this point all information collected since Oct 19th to date has only confirmed the response that distributed to the Council in writing on Oct 18: there has been no overlap between the publicly funded tax outreach voter education activities, and the campaigns of any local candidates such as Mayor Beltran. To the extent that unsubstantiated accusations are being made by other candidates or by residents or by any other persons, City staff continues to have an obligation to investigate and respond appropriately given the seriousness of the legal requirements for the use of public funds. Staff is ready at all times to receive information or documentation that is causing any concern of any kind.

AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES ("Agreement") is made and entered into this September 26, 2018 by and between City of Parlier ("Client"), and GlobalCommunicationsLLC.net DBA Global Communications ("Consultant"). For valuable consideration, Client and Consultant agree:

1. Term.

This Agreement is for services approved beginning September 6, 2018 and will continue until terminated at will by either party without notice required.

Services.

Consultant shall perform the Services in accordance with all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations, exercising the standard of care applicable to Consultant's profession.

5. <u>Lobbyist Registration</u>

No lobbyist registration is expected to be required for the services under this Agreement.

No Condition to Payment.

It is the intention of the parties to this Agreement that the Services rendered hereunder and the payments made hereunder and the payments made therefore are not in any way contingent upon the defeat or enactment of any legislative or administrative proposal or the achievement of any specific result. Consultant has made no representation or warranties regarding the achievement of any particular result or results. The parties hereto agree that such sums as are paid pursuant to this Agreement shall be deemed to be the reasonable value of services rendered hereunder. Consultant does not guarantee any specific results in connection with the provision of services.

Independent Contractor.

It is the intention of the parties to this Agreement that the Services rendered hereunder shall be so rendered by Consultant as an independent contractor and not as an employee, agent, joint venturer or partner of Client. Nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted or construed as creating or establishing the relationship of employer and employee between Client and Consultant or any employee or agent of Consultant. Both parties acknowledge that Consultant is not an employee for state or federal tax purposes. Consultant shall retain the right to perform services for others under terms of this Agreement during the entire term hereof.

a. Workers Compensation.

Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance for its employees in accordance with the laws of the State of California. The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against City, its officers, employees, agents, and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by Consultant for City.

b. Automobile Liability Coverage.

Automobile Liability Insurance covering bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage for all activities of Consultant arising out of or in connection with the work to be performed under this Agreement, including coverage for owned, hired and non-owned vehicles. This insurance shall be in the minimum amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) combined single limit for each occurrence.

c. Endorsements.

The General Liability Insurance and Automobile Liability Insurance shall be endorsed with the following language:

- (i) The City, its elected or appointed officers, employees, agents and volunteers are to be covered as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of work performed by or on behalf of Consultant, including materials, parts or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations.
- (ii) This policy shall be considered primary insurance as respects to City, its elected or appointed officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers. Any insurance maintained by City, including any self-insured retention City may have, shall be considered excess insurance only and shall not contribute with it.
- (iii) This insurance shall act for each insured and additional insureds as though a separate policy had been written for each, except with respect to the limits of liability of the insuring company.
- (iv) The insurer waives all rights of subrogation against City, its elected or appointed officials, officers, employees or agents.
- (v) Any failure to comply with reporting provisions of the policies shall not affect coverage provided to the City, its elected or appointed officers, officials, employees, agents or volunteers.
- (vi) The insurance provided by this policy shall not be suspended, voided, canceled, or reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days written notice has been received by City.

d. Certificates of Insurance.

Consultant shall provide certificates of insurance with original endorsements to City as evidence of the insurance coverage required herein within 90 days of commencement of work under this Agreement. Renewal certificates shall be kept on file at the City upon expiration of any annual policy.

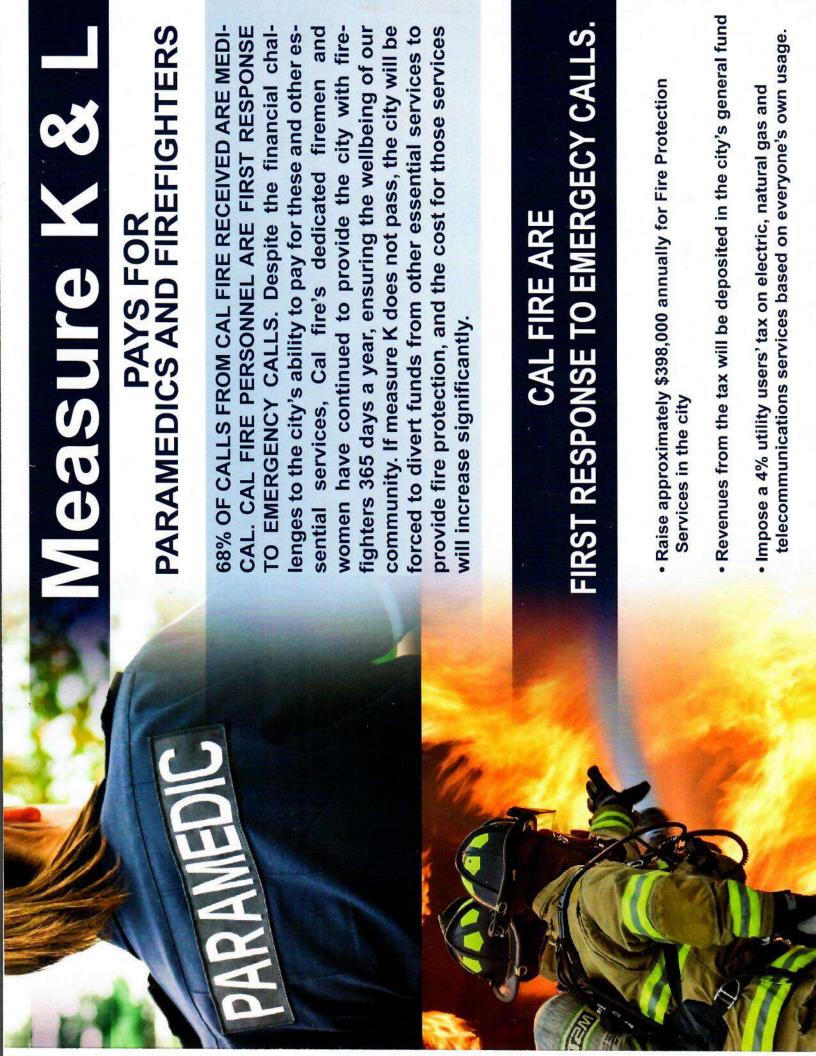
