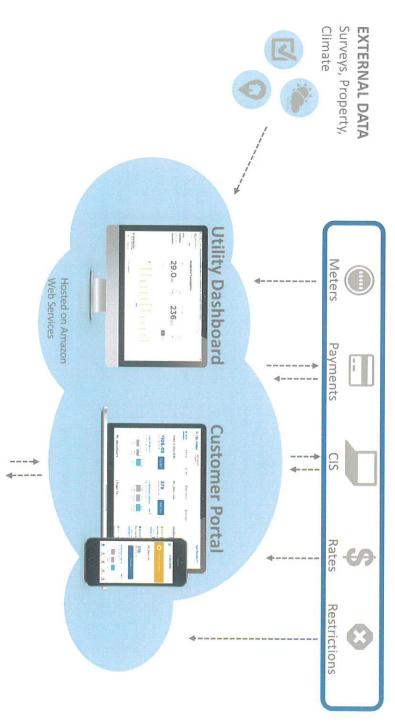

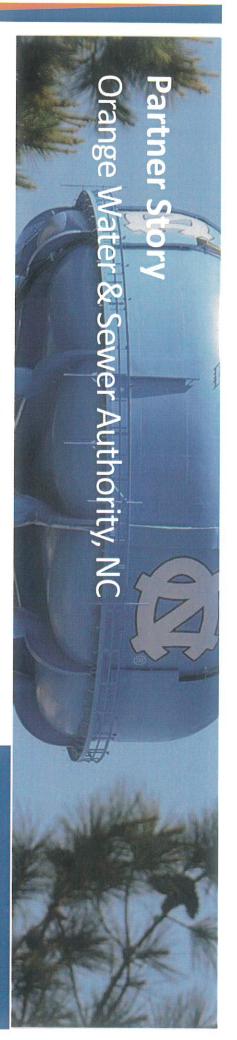

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Site Size:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopts Resolution No. 2021-21, approving a conditional use permit for the operation of a tobacco shop at 690 Fresno Street.

#### BACKGROUND:

#### PROPOSAL & DISCUSSION:

The applicant has proposed to operate a tobacco shop in an empty tenant space within an existing structure on Fresno Street. The proposed store would primarily sell tobacco and vape products. The proposed hours of operation are from 9:00 AM to 9:00 AM seven days per week. The estimated number of employees during operation is 2. Facility security includes the use of cameras, motion detectors, and ample lighting sources. The site currently supports four parking spaces; in order to meet ADA requirements, the two spaces located towards Fresno Street need to be converted into an accessible van space and loading area. Additional on-street parking is available.

Ordinance No. 2019-05 removed the prohibition of such facilities within 300 feet of certain land uses such as residences, schools, parks, and public facilities; however, proximity to

these types of uses must still be considered. In order to ensure compatibility with those uses, City Council may impose conditions of approval that it deems necessary.

This project originally appeared on the April 15, 2021 City Council agenda. The applicant was not able to be present at that meeting, so the City Council continued the item to its May 6, 2021 regular meeting.

#### **FINDINGS:**

#### Conditional Use Permit

Prior to approving a site plan, the City Council must make findings as prescribed by Parlier Municipal Code Section 18.38.070:

- 1. The site for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate the use and all yards, spaces, walls and fences, parking, loading, landscaping, and other features required to adjust the use with land and uses in the neighborhood.
  - The proposed use would occur within an existing structure. Improvements to the structure and site will provide for a more aesthetic, safe, and secure facility and will serve to adjust the use to the neighborhood.
- 2. The site for the proposed use relates to streets and highways adequate in width and pavement type to carry the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the proposed use.
  - Access to and from K Street is not an important consideration since although the site has access to K Street, it would utilize on-street parking. On-street parking is also available on Fresno Street immediately to the north. It is not anticipated that the use will generate a quantity or type of traffic that would substantially affect the City's circulation system.
- 3. The proposed use will have no adverse effect on abutting property of the permitted use thereof.
  - The City Council has imposed operational conditions that it deems sufficient to minimize or eliminate adverse effects to the neighborhood.
- 4. The conditions stated in the resolution are deemed necessary to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare.
  - All conditions of approval stem from the Parlier Municipal Code or are otherwise required in order to prevent undue effects of the operation from damaging the public health, safety, and welfare.

#### Environmental

The first step in complying with CEQA is to determine whether the activity in question constitutes a "project" as defined by CEQA, Public Resources Code Section 21000, *et seq.* and the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations Section 15000, *et seq.* A

"project" consists of the whole of an action (i.e. not the individual pieces or components) that may have a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect effect on the environment. The second step is to determine whether the project is subject to or exempt from the statute. This proposal qualifies as a project under CEQA because it involves the issuance to a person of a "lease, permit, license, certificate, or other entitlement for use" as described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15378.

The proposed use would occur within an existing structure on a site that is already developed. CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, Existing Facilities, allows for operation, repair, and maintenance of existing private structures and facilities. Staff believes that the project falls within this classification and that it is categorically exempt from CEQA.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Review and processing of the site plan review application, engineering plans, and building plans are paid for by the applicant. Since the previous operation was in effect at the time the City developed its development impact fee schedule and the proposed use will occupy the existing site and structure, the project is not responsible for payment of development impact fees.

WHEREAS, Elie Aljalhoom wishes to operate a smoke shop ("Project") within an existing structure at 690 K Street, Fresno County Assessor's Parcel No. ("APN") 355-082-01 ("Site"); and

WHEREAS, the Site is zoned C-4 Central Trading, which allows the proposed use subject to City issuance of a conditional use permit; and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2021 a notice of public hearing was published in *The Business Journal* announcing the project and the opportunity to comment thereon and said notice was also posted at Parlier City Hall; and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2021 a similar notice of public hearing was mailed to owners of real property within 300 feet of the project site; and

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting on April 15, 2021 the Parlier City Council did, by a 4-0 vote, continue the item to its May 6, 2021 regular meeting; and

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting on May 6, 2021 the Parlier City Council did conduct a public hearing to consider the conditional permit; and

WHEREAS, approval of a conditional use permit consists of a "lease, permit, license, certificate, or other entitlement for use", and is therefore a "project" pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code Section 21000, *et seq.* ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations Section 15000, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, as the agency primarily responsible for carrying out or approving said project, the City of Parlier assumes the role of lead agency pursuant to CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that the proposed project consists of operation, repair, and maintenance of privately-owned facilities and structures, and therefore the project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to PMC Section 18.38.070, the City Council has made the following findings, the evidence for said findings substantiated within the record:

- 1. The site for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate the use and all yards, spaces, walls and fences, parking, loading, landscaping, and other features required to adjust the use with land and uses in the neighborhood.
- 2. The site for the proposed use relates to streets and highways adequate in width and pavement type to carry the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the proposed use.

- 3. The proposed use will have no adverse effect on abutting property of the permitted use thereof.
- 4. The conditions stated in the resolution are deemed necessary to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare.

#### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Parlier City Council finds the proposal to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.
- 2. The Parlier City Council approves the conditional use permit for 690 K Street (APN 355-082-01) subject to the conditions detailed in Attachment "A" hereto.

#### ATTACHMENT "A" TO RESOLUTION NO. 2021-21 CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL 690 K Street (APN 355-082-01) SMOKE SHOP (ELIE ALJALHOOM)

As may be used herein, the words "owner," "operator", and "applicant" shall be interchangeable, excepting when the word is indicated in *bold italics*. In that event, the condition of approval is specific to the entity named.

#### **Conditional Use Permit**

- 1. Approval of this conditional use permit plan shall be valid for a period not to exceed two (2) years from the date of approval unless the approved use has commenced, or if, in the estimation of the Community Development Director, necessary improvements that are requisite to operation are being pursued. The owner may request an extension of up to one (1) additional year via written request to the Community Development Director submitted not less than thirty (30) days prior to expiration of the conditional use permit approval. The pending expiration shall be tolled until such time as the City Council acts on the request for extension.
- 2. Hours of operation may occur between 9:00 AM and 9:00 PM up to seven days per week. Deliveries shall occur during normal business hours.
- 3. The City will monitor the operation for violations of conditions of approval. Penalty for violation may include but is not limited to warnings, fines, and/or permit revocation.

#### Site Plan

#### General

- 4. Any modifications to the site, aside from parking conversion per Condition No. 13 herein, will be subject to site plan review.
- 5. Development and operation shall comply with all applicable provisions of the City of Parlier General Plan and the Parlier Municipal Code (PMC), including but not limited to: potable water protection regulations (Chapter 13.30), business licensing requirements (Title 5), and Building Code Standards (Title 15); the Subdivision Ordinance (Title 16); the regulations of the applicable zone district(s) and other relevant portions of the Zoning Ordinance (Title 18); and the City of Parlier Standard Specifications and Standard Drawings, unless exceptions therefrom are approved by the City Engineer.
- 6. Use of the site shall conform to all applicable City requirements for the C-4 Central Trading Zone District.
- 7. Construction drawings (building and improvement Plans; site, grading, irrigation, and landscaping) shall be submitted to the Community Development Department for review and approval. A building permit shall be acquired prior to start of any construction activities.
- 8. All exterior lights shall be shielded or otherwise oriented to prevent disturbance to surrounding or neighboring properties or traffic on abutting rights-of-way.

- 9. The applicant shall consult with and shall comply with the requirements of the Fresno County Fire Protection District/CAL FIRE, including but not limited to requirements related to sprinklers, fire hydrants, and fire access.
- 10. The **owner** shall comply with the provisions of Resolution No. 2019-12 regarding installation of video cameras for use by the Parlier Police Department.
- 11. The developer shall comply with Health and Safety Code Section 7050.5 and Public Resources Code Sections 5097.98, 21083.2, and 21084.1 and related statutes regarding regulation of cultural and historical resources that may be discovered on the site.
- 12. Prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy, all conditions of approval shall be verified as complete by the Community Development Department, and any and all outstanding fees shall have been paid. Any discrepancy or difference in interpretation of the conditions between the owner/ applicant/ operator and the Community Development Department shall be subject to review and determination by the City Council.

#### Site

- 13. The site currently supports six (6) parking spaces. Prior to operation, applicant shall have converted the two (2) spaces closest to Fresno Street into an accessible van space and associated loading area consistent with applicable standards. Following conversion, the site shall maintain the two (4) standard spaces and the one (1) accessible van space. The site may also utilize existing on-street parking.
- 14. Any proposed improvements to the exterior of the structure, including but not limited to the façade design, awning, surfacing, paint, articulations, etc. shall be subject to review and approval by the City Planner.
- 15. The applicant shall coordinate with Mid Valley Disposal to establish necessary solid waste procedures (i.e., collection days and frequency). As necessary, construction of trash enclosures shall comply with City of Parlier Standard Drawing No. M-12, Type "E" or as determined by the City Engineer.
- 16. The owner/applicant shall comply with all relevant components of the California Building Standards Code and associated trade codes, including but not limited to issues related to restroom facilities, building occupancy limits, and fire prevention and safety.
- 17. All signage must be approved pursuant to the standards and guidelines of the Parlier Municipal Code prior to installation.
- 18. The owner/operator of the facility shall be responsible for the ongoing and long-term maintenance of required improvements and landscaping. As required by CA Streets and Highways Code Sections 5600-5630, this shall include curb, and gutter, and planter strip.

#### Utilities

- 19. The development shall at all times respect existing or new easements by, for, and between all private and public entities, including but not limited to the City of Parlier and the Consolidated Irrigation District.
- 20. It shall be the responsibility of the owner/developer to grant easements as necessary for the installation and maintenance of private utilities, including but not limited to: electricity, gas, telephone, and cable television.

#### Streets

21. Any work within the City of Parlier public right-of-way shall require an encroachment permit.

#### <u>Fees</u>

- 22. Owner shall be responsible for payment of any and all outstanding planning, building, plan check, and engineering fees prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy.
- 23. Concurrently with submission of improvement and/or building plans, the applicant shall deposit with the City of Parlier funds in an amount estimated by the City Engineer and/or Building Official, respectively, to be sufficient to offset costs to the City for review of such plans. In the event that such funds are not sufficient to cover costs to the City, the City Engineer and/or Building Official, as appropriate, shall contact the applicant to request additional funds, which the applicant shall then deposit with the City.
- 24. The project is not responsible for payment of development impact fees

## REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL

#### SUBJECT:

City Council to Consider Amendments to Parlier Municipal Code Chapter 18.55 Regarding Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council introduces and waives the first reading of Ordinance No. 2021-XX and sets a public hearing for May 20, 2021.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Legalization of marijuana/cannabis, whether for medicinal or recreational use, has been a hotly-debated topic in California and elsewhere for decades. Please see the timeline below for a summary of cannabis legalization in California.

- In 1996, with the adoption of Proposition 215, the California voters approved the "Compassionate Use Act" (Health and Safety Code Section 11362.5). This Act was intended to ensure that seriously ill Californians have the right to obtain and use marijuana for medical purposes where that medical use is deemed appropriate and has been recommended by a physician, without fear of criminal prosecution under limited, specified circumstances.
- In 2004, the State Legislature enacted SB 420, which clarified the scope of the Compassionate Use Act and provided additional statutory guidance regarding medical marijuana use. These statutes are codified at Health and Safety Code Section 11362.7, et seq., and allow cities and counties to adopt supplemental rules and regulations.
- In 2009, the City of Parlier adopted an express ban on medical marijuana dispensaries and prohibited cultivation except as allowed through State-authorized collectives and cooperatives.
- On October 9, 2015, almost 20 years after passage of the Compassionate Use Act, the Governor signed the "Medical Marijuana Regulation and Safety Act" ("MMRSA"), comprising California legislative bills AB 243, AB 266, and SB 643. MMRSA created a comprehensive State licensing system for the commercial cultivation, manufacture, retail sale, transport, distribution, delivery, and testing of medical cannabis, all subject

to local control. One of the purposes of MMRSA was to ensure uniformity among jurisdictions that wished to allow commercial marijuana operations.

- On June 27, 2016, the Governor signed SB 837, effective immediately, changing the
  terms in MMRSA from "medical marijuana" or "marijuana" to "medical cannabis" or
  "cannabis," and making other technical changes (now called "MCRSA"). SB 837 also
  adopted regulations relating to the use and diversion of water in connection with the
  cultivation of cannabis.
- On February 3, 2016, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2016-02, further restricting medical marijuana activities in the City.
- On November 8, 2016, California voters approved the "Adult Use of Marijuana Act" ("AUMA"). The purpose of AUMA is to establish a comprehensive system to legalize, control and regulate the cultivation, processing, manufacture, distribution, testing, and sale of non-medical marijuana, including marijuana products. Adults, age 21 and older, are allowed to possess marijuana and grow certain amounts at home for personal use.
- On June 27, 2017, the Governor signed SB 94, effective immediately, to consolidate and reconcile MCRSA and AUMA into a single regulatory system. SB 94 repealed MCRSA and created the Medicinal and Adult Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act ("MAUCRSA").
- On September 16, 2017, the Governor signed AB 133, effective immediately, making changes to MAUCRSA.
- On November 15, 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2017-03, the Cannabis Control Ordinance, putting in place the standards by which commercial cannabis operations would be regulated.

The City Council has since adopted additional amendments to its cannabis control ordinance to authorize delivery and allow for dispensaries and is in the process of another amendment to clarify the dispensary provisions.

Most recently, the City has received a proposal from GBH Cultivation, LLC (GBH) to amend the cannabis regulatory permit issued to Greenbrier Holdings, LLC in 2017. The permit allows for indoor mixed-light cultivation on three properties in the industrial park along with the manufacturing and laboratory facility currently operating on S. Milton Avenue. GBH has requested that the City amend the text of the zoning ordinance to allow outdoor cultivation, which is currently prohibited. The City Council is not being asked to amend the regulatory permit at this time. The only items under consideration are the proposed zoning text changes. The permit modification would be brought to the Council at a future public hearing following public notification.

#### PROPOSAL & DISCUSSION:

At this time, based on the request of the applicant, staff proposes changes to the portions of Chapter 18.55 that expressly or impliedly prohibit outdoor commercial cannabis cultivation.

Specifically, this involves adding language to Section 18.55.070(C)(15) which requires ventilation and exhaust, implying that all operations must occur within a building, and Section 18.55.070(C)(16), which expressly states that all commercial cannabis activities must occur entirely within a building.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

If approved, this ordinance amendment would allow the City Council to consider approval of outdoor cultivation subject to a regulatory permit.

#### **Environmental**

The first step in complying with CEQA is to determine whether the activity in question constitutes a "project" as defined by CEQA, Public Resources Code Section 21000, et seq. and the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations Section 15000, et seq. A "project" consists of the whole of an action (i.e., not the individual pieces or components) that may have a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect effect on the environment. The second step is to determine whether the project is subject to or exempt from the statute. This proposal qualifies as a project under CEQA because it involves an amendment to the zoning ordinance, which expressly falls within the definition of "project" in CEQA Guidelines Section 15378. Further, the whole of the action includes development of the site with a commercial cannabis facility. At the time the original regulatory permit was approved, the City Council made a determination pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15183(a), which is based upon Public Resources Code Section 21083.3, and which provides statutory exemption from CEQA for projects meeting the required criteria:

"(a) CEQA mandates that projects which are consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are particular to the project or its site. This streamlines the review of such projects and reduces the need to prepare repetitive environmental studies."

Prior to adoption of the 2010 General Plan Update, the City Council certified the Final Environmental Impact Report prepared in conjunction with the General Plan Update. The EIR identified, analyzed, and proposed all feasible mitigation to reduce potentially significant environmental impacts to less than significant levels, unless said impacts were unable to feasibly be so mitigated. The City Council made findings and adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations indicating that, although adoption and implementation of the General Plan could result in significant and unavoidable impacts, the benefits of the General Plan outweighed these impacts.

For the subject project, staff prepared an environmental checklist, the intention of which was to examine environmental effects that might be project specific or otherwise peculiar to the site. None were identified. Thus, given that the proposed project is consistent with and serves to implement the General Plan for which an EIR was certified, and analysis of the project did not identify any peculiar circumstances that could result in a significant environmental effect, staff recommends a finding that the proposed action is not subject to any additional environmental review, and is statutorily exempt from CEQA under Public Resources Code Section 21083.3(b).

The above determination would also accommodate the proposed text amendment, which itself is intended to help implement the General Plan.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

The application to amend the zoning text is paid for by application fees.

## REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL

#### SUBJECT:

Consider zoning text amendments affecting cannabis dispensaries.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council waives the second reading of and adopts Ordinance No. 2021-02, amending Parlier Municipal Code Section 18.32.020(A) and Chapter 18.55 regarding cannabis dispensaries.

#### BACKGROUND:

On November 19, 2020 the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2020-5, which made certain amendments to Chapter 18.55 (the Cannabis Control Ordinance) of the Parlier Municipal Code (PMC) intended to authorize the Council to approve operation of a maximum of one (1) cannabis dispensary with the Parlier city limits. Under the revised provisions, such a dispensary would be subject to approval of a cannabis regulatory permit at the Council's discretion.

The Cannabis Control Ordinance notwithstanding, in order for a use to be allowed, it must be listed in at least one zone district as permitted, conditionally-permitted, or permitted subject to commission review and approval. Currently, no zone in the Parlier zoning ordinance allows dispensaries. Similarly, there are subsections within Chapter 18.55 that still serve to prohibit retail cannabis.

On March 18, 2021 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-16, directing staff to prepare a text amendment to add cannabis dispensaries to the list of permitted uses—subject to the provisions of the Cannabis Control Ordinance—in the C-4 Central Trading Zone district. There would still be a maximum of one (1) dispensary permitted and it would still be subject to approval of a cannabis regulatory permit at the City Council's discretion.

On April 15, 2021 the City Council conducted a public hearing and introduced and waived the first reading of Ordinance No. 2021-02.

#### PROPOSAL & DISCUSSION:

While preparing the ordinance amendment, staff noticed other provisions of Chapter 18.55 that, without further amendment, would frustrate the Council's intentions. For example:

- Section 18.55.070(B) does not list "Sale" or similar as a potentially allowable operation
- Section 18.55.070(C)(3) prohibits signage
- Section 18.55.070(C)(9) expressly prohibits cannabis retail sale

Staff proposes that, while these other amendments were not specifically directed by Council, they are sufficiently related such that including them in the zoning text amendment is logical and is necessary to accomplish the Council's stated intention in initiating the text amendment in the first instance.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL:**

The first step in complying with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is to determine whether the activity in question constitutes a "project" as defined by CEQA, Public Resources Code Section 21000, et seq. and the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations Section 15000, et seq. The second step is to determine whether the project is subject to or exempt from the statute. This proposal qualifies as a project under CEQA because it involves the issuance to a person of a "lease, permit, license, certificate, or other entitlement for use" as described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15378.

However, the proposed ordinance amendment does not approve or otherwise authorize any specific activity that could result in a physical change to the environment; it is solely an amendment to regulations. In cases where it can be shown with certainty that the project being considered has no possibility of causing a significant impact to the environment, the project is not subject to CEQA as indicated in Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Estimated staff time amounting to less than \$1,000 for preparation of reports, resolution, and ordinance and for meeting attendance, plus approximately \$500 for public noticing.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2021-02**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARLIER AMENDING SECTION 18.24.020(A) AND CHAPTER 18.55 OF THE PARLIER MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING CANNABIS DISPENSARIES

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2020 the City Council of the City of Parlier adopted Ordinance No. 2020-5, amending Chapter 18.55 of the Parlier Municipal Code to authorize operation of a single cannabis dispensary within Parlier subject to City Council approval of a cannabis regulatory permit; and

WHEREAS, at present "cannabis dispensary" or similar use is not listed as a permitted or conditionally-permitted use in any zone district within Parlier; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate implementation of Ordinance No. 2020-5, "cannabis dispensary" must be listed as a permitted or conditionally-permitted use in at least one zone district; and

WHEREAS, certain conflicting provisions of Chapter 18.55 remain in place that effectively maintain the prohibition on dispensaries; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARLIER DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Section 18.24.020(A) of Chapter 18.24 of Title 18 of the Parlier Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### A. Retail:

Appliance store;

Antique shop;

Bakery;

Cannabis dispensaries, subject to the provisions of Chapter 18.55;

Clothing;

Confectionary (candy) with some manufacturing;

Dress shop:

Drug store:

Department store;

Furniture store, new and used:

Food store:

Food markets:

Hobby shop:

Hardware store:

Jewelry store;

Liquor store;

Musical instruments:

Notions;

Pet shop

Pool hall;

Plants:

Stationery stores;

Variety store.

Section II. Section 18.55.020(A) of Chapter 18.55 of Title 18 of the Parlier Municipal Code is hereby amended to include the following definition:

"Sell" and "sale(s)" shall have the meaning set forth in California Business and Professions Code Section 26001, subdivision (as).

- Section III. Section 18.55.050(B) of Chapter 18.55 of Title 18 of the Parlier Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - B. Dispensaries. A single cannabis dispensary as defined in Section 18.55.020 is allowed within the City of Parlier if authorized by regulatory permit and site plan review of the premises where the dispensary will be operated.
- Section IV. Section 18.55.070(B) of Chapter 18.55 of Title 18 of the Parlier Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - B. Permitted Uses. Business Owners meeting the requirements of this section shall be eligible to apply for a Regulatory Permit to conduct the following Commercial Cannabis Operations, as may be approved by the City Council at its discretion:
    - Cultivation.
    - Processing.
    - Extraction.
    - Manufacturing.
    - Testing.
    - Distribution.
    - Transportation.
    - Sales.
- Section V. Section 18.55.070(C) of Chapter 18.55 of Title 18 of the Parlier Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - C. Minimum Operational Requirements and Restrictions. The following operational requirements and restrictions shall apply to all Commercial Cannabis Operations:
    - The Act and Other State Laws. The Commercial Cannabis Operations shall at all times be in compliance with the Act and the implementing regulations, as they may be amended from time to time, as well as all State license(s) required under the Act, and any other applicable State law. The Operator shall obtain all licenses required under the Act prior to opening for business.

- 2. Register of Employees. The Operator shall maintain a current register of the names of persons required to have Employee Permits. The register shall be made available to the Police Chief at all times immediately upon request.
- 3. Signage. Except as may be approved pursuant to a Regulatory Permit, there There shall be no signage or markings on the Premises or off-site that in any way evidence that Commercial Cannabis Operations are occurring on the property. Interior building signage is permissible provided the signage is not visible outside of the building.
- 4. Cannabis Consumption. No cannabis or cannabis product shall be smoked, ingested or otherwise consumed on the Premises. Prominent signage of this prohibition shall be displayed throughout the facility.
- 5. Alcoholic Beverages. No Commercial Cannabis Operation shall hold or maintain a retail license from the State Department of Alcohol Beverage Control to sell alcoholic beverages, or operate a business that sells alcoholic beverages. In addition, alcohol for personal consumption shall not be provided, stored, kept, located, sold, dispensed, or used on the Premises.
- 6. Transportation. Transportation shall be permitted, so long as consistent with State law.
- 7. Deliveries. Deliveries of cannabis or cannabis-containing products, or distribution of the same from the Premises shall be permitted so long as it is consistent with State law.
- 8. Non-Commercial Cannabis Activity. No non-commercial or Recreational Marijuana activity shall occur on the Premises.
- 9. Retail Sales. The retail sale of cannabis is—expressly prohibited shall be permitted, so long as consistent with State law and this Chapter.
- Public Access. There shall be no public access to the Premises. Public access is allowed for the Dispensary allowed by a regulatory permit at a site approved by the City.
- 11. Minors. It shall be unlawful for any Operator to employ any person who is not at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 12. Distance Separation from Schools, Daycare Centers and Youth Centers. A Commercial Cannabis Operation shall not be located within 1000 feet from any existing school, daycare center or youth center as defined by State law, nor from a proposed school site as identified in the General Plan. Measurements shall be from property boundary to property boundary. For purposes of this section, "school" means any public or private school providing instruction in kindergarten or grades 1-12, inclusive, but does not include any private school in which education is primarily conducted in private homes.
- 13. Hours of Operation. Commercial Cannabis Operations shall be allowed to operate per the requirements of the underlying zone district and subject to the City's noise and nuisance ordinances.
- 14. Building and Related Codes. The Cannabis Operation shall be subject to the following requirements:
  - a. The Premises in which the Commercial Cannabis Operations occur shall comply with all applicable local, State, and federal laws, rules, and regulations including, but not limited to, building codes and the Americans with Disabilities Act, as certified by the Building Official of the City. The

- Operator shall obtain all required building permits and comply with all applicable City standards.
- b. The Responsible Party shall ensure that the Premises has sufficient electrical load for the Commercial Cannabis Operations.
- c. To the extent permitted by the Act, butane and other flammable materials are permitted to be used for extraction and processing provided the Operator complies with all applicable fire and building codes, and any other laws and regulations relating to the use of those products, to ensure the safety of that operation. The Fresno County Fire Protection District, or other qualified agency retained by the City, shall inspect and approve the Premises for use of the products prior to City's issuance of a certificate of occupancy, or otherwise prior to opening for business, to ensure compliance with this requirement. Such inspection shall be at the Business Owner's expense.
- d. The Operator shall comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to use of commercial kitchen facilities for the Commercial Cannabis Operations.
- e. The Operator shall comply with all environmental laws and regulations pertaining to the Commercial Cannabis Operations, including the storage, use and disposal of water and pesticides, and shall otherwise use best practices to avoid environmental harm.
- 15. Odor control. Business Owner shall provide an odor-absorbing ventilation and exhaust system, so that odor generated inside the facility that is distinctive to its Commercial Cannabis Operations is not detected outside the Premises, outside the building housing the Commercial Cannabis Operations, or anywhere on adjacent property or public rights-of-way. Accordingly, Business Owner must install and maintain the following equipment or any other equipment which the City's Building Official determines has the same or better effectiveness:
  - a. An exhaust air filtration system with odor control that prevents internal odors and pollen from being emitted externally; or
  - b. An air system that creates negative air pressure between the cannabis facility's interior and exterior so that the odors generated inside the cannabis facility are not detectable outside the cannabis facility.
- 16. Consumable Products. Commercial Cannabis Operations that manufacture products in the form of food or other comestibles shall obtain and maintain all appropriate approvals from the State and County Departments of Public Health for the provision of food or other comestibles, unless otherwise governed by the Act and licensed by the State.
- 17. Secure Building. All Commercial Cannabis Operations shall occur entirely inside of a building that shall be secure, locked, and fully enclosed, with a ceiling, roof or top, and entirely opaque. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the roof may be of solid non-opaque material, provided other security measures exist to ensure that the Commercial Cannabis Operation cannot be seen, heard or smelled beyond the property line. The building shall include a burglar alarm monitored by an alarm company or private security company. The building, including all walls, doors, and the roof, shall be of solid construction meeting the minimum building code requirements for industrial structures (including, without limitation, commercial greenhouse structures). The precise building construction parameters and

materials to be used shall be identified and provided with the application to the City prior to construction.

- 18. Premises Security. The following security conditions shall apply:
  - a. Alarm System (including perimeter, fire and panic).
  - b. Remote monitoring of alarm systems.
  - c. Perimeter lighting systems (motion sensor) for after-hours security.
  - d. Perimeter security and lighting as approved by the Police Chief.
  - e. Use of drive gates with card key access or similar to access the facility.
  - f. Entrance areas to be locked at all times, and under the control of a designated Responsible Party.
  - g. Use of access-control systems to limit access to grow and processing areas.
  - h. Exterior and interior camera systems approved by the Police Chief. The camera systems shall meet the minimum requirements of the Act, include interior monitoring of all access points to the site from the interior, and be of a minimum five (5) mega-pixel resolution.
  - i. All security systems at the site are attached to an uninterruptable power supply providing 24-hour power.
  - j. 24-hour security patrols by a recognized security company licensed by the California Department of Consumer Affairs or otherwise acceptable to the Police Chief. All current contact information regarding the security company shall be provided to the Police Chief.
  - k. Parlier Police Department or Department designee shall have access to all security systems.
  - I. Internet Protocol ("IP") access for remote monitoring of security cameras by the Parlier Police Department or a department designee upon request.
  - m. Any and all video or audio tape recordings made for security purposes shall be marked with the date and time made and shall be kept, in an unaltered state, for a period of at least thirty (30) days and must be made available to the Parlier Police Department or Department designee for duplication upon demand. In addition, upon request by the Parlier Police Department, the Responsible Party shall duplicate the records for the Parlier Police Department or the department designee.
  - n. Hardened bullet-resistant windows for exterior windows as part of any new or existing construction.
  - o. Accounting software systems need to be in place to provide audit trails of both product and cash, where applicable.
  - p. Electronic track-and-trace systems for cannabis products as required by the Act and State regulations.
  - q. The City may inspect the Premises and audit the records of the Commercial Cannabis Operations for compliance on a quarterly basis.
  - r. Security protocols and equipment need to be in place to protect computer information.
  - s. The foregoing Premises Security requirements shall be approved by the Police Chief prior to commencing Operations. The Police Chief may supplement these security requirements once Operations begin, subject to review by the City Council if requested by the Business Owner.

- 19. Deliveries of Supplies and Transportation of Product. The following rules apply to the Deliveries and transportation:
  - a. Deliveries of supplies to the Premises shall only occur as provided for in diagram and floor plans on file with the City as part of the application process. Delivery vehicles shall not have any markings indicating that deliveries are being made to a Cannabis Operation.
  - b. The transportation of cannabis samples and/or products to and from the Premises shall be in unmarked vehicles with no indication that the vehicles are transporting cannabis samples and/or products. The Responsible Party shall stagger transportation times, vary routes from the facility, and take other security measures as requested by the Police Chief.
- 20. Premises Maintenance. The Business Owner, Operator, and all Responsible Parties shall continually maintain the Premises and its infrastructure so that it is visually attractive and not dangerous to the health, safety, and general welfare of employees, patrons, surrounding properties, and the general public. The Premises or Commercial Cannabis Operation shall not be maintained in a manner that causes a public or private nuisance.
- 21. Location of Uses. The Commercial Cannabis Operation permitted by this section shall only be allowed in the locations designated on the diagram and floor plans of the Premises submitted with the application for a Regulatory Permit. The Commercial Cannabis Operation shall not operate at any location other than as stated in the Regulatory Permit.
- Section VI. California Environmental Quality Act: As defined in CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(a)(1), a "project" expressly includes an amendment to a zoning ordinance. However, the City Council of the City of Parlier hereby finds that the zoning text amendments contained herein solely constitute changes to regulations and do not authorize or approve any development or physical changes. As such, they have no potential to significantly affect the environment, and are therefore not subject to CEQA as indicated in CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
- Section VII. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases have been declared invalid or unconstitutional.
- Section VIII. Effective Date and Posting of Ordinance: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after the date of final passage. The City Clerk of the City of Parlier shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once within fifteen (15) days after its passage in a newspaper of general circulation in Fresno County with the names of those City Council Members voting for or against the Ordinance.

## REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL

#### SUBJECT:

City Council to Consider Amendments to Parlier Municipal Code Chapter 18.55 Regarding Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council introduces and waives the first reading of Ordinance No. 2021-XX and sets a public hearing for May 20, 2021.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Legalization of marijuana/cannabis, whether for medicinal or recreational use, has been a hotly-debated topic in California and elsewhere for decades. Please see the timeline below for a summary of cannabis legalization in California.

- In 1996, with the adoption of Proposition 215, the California voters approved the "Compassionate Use Act" (Health and Safety Code Section 11362.5). This Act was intended to ensure that seriously ill Californians have the right to obtain and use marijuana for medical purposes where that medical use is deemed appropriate and has been recommended by a physician, without fear of criminal prosecution under limited, specified circumstances.
- In 2004, the State Legislature enacted SB 420, which clarified the scope of the Compassionate Use Act and provided additional statutory guidance regarding medical marijuana use. These statutes are codified at Health and Safety Code Section 11362.7, et seq., and allow cities and counties to adopt supplemental rules and regulations.
- In 2009, the City of Parlier adopted an express ban on medical marijuana dispensaries and prohibited cultivation except as allowed through State-authorized collectives and cooperatives.
- On October 9, 2015, almost 20 years after passage of the Compassionate Use Act, the Governor signed the "Medical Marijuana Regulation and Safety Act" ("MMRSA"), comprising California legislative bills AB 243, AB 266, and SB 643. MMRSA created a comprehensive State licensing system for the commercial cultivation, manufacture, retail sale, transport, distribution, delivery, and testing of medical cannabis, all subject

to local control. One of the purposes of MMRSA was to ensure uniformity among jurisdictions that wished to allow commercial marijuana operations.

- On June 27, 2016, the Governor signed SB 837, effective immediately, changing the
  terms in MMRSA from "medical marijuana" or "marijuana" to "medical cannabis" or
  "cannabis," and making other technical changes (now called "MCRSA"). SB 837 also
  adopted regulations relating to the use and diversion of water in connection with the
  cultivation of cannabis.
- On February 3, 2016, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2016-02, further restricting medical marijuana activities in the City.
- On November 8, 2016, California voters approved the "Adult Use of Marijuana Act" ("AUMA"). The purpose of AUMA is to establish a comprehensive system to legalize, control and regulate the cultivation, processing, manufacture, distribution, testing, and sale of non-medical marijuana, including marijuana products. Adults, age 21 and older, are allowed to possess marijuana and grow certain amounts at home for personal use.
- On June 27, 2017, the Governor signed SB 94, effective immediately, to consolidate and reconcile MCRSA and AUMA into a single regulatory system. SB 94 repealed MCRSA and created the Medicinal and Adult Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act ("MAUCRSA").
- On September 16, 2017, the Governor signed AB 133, effective immediately, making changes to MAUCRSA.
- On November 15, 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2017-03, the Cannabis Control Ordinance, putting in place the standards by which commercial cannabis operations would be regulated.

The City Council has since adopted additional amendments to its cannabis control ordinance to authorize delivery and allow for dispensaries and is in the process of another amendment to clarify the dispensary provisions.

Most recently, the City has received a proposal from GBH Cultivation, LLC (GBH) to amend the cannabis regulatory permit issued to Greenbrier Holdings, LLC in 2017. The permit allows for indoor mixed-light cultivation on three properties in the industrial park along with the manufacturing and laboratory facility currently operating on S. Milton Avenue. GBH has requested that the City amend the text of the zoning ordinance to allow outdoor cultivation, which is currently prohibited. The City Council is not being asked to amend the regulatory permit at this time. The only items under consideration are the proposed zoning text changes. The permit modification would be brought to the Council at a future public hearing following public notification.

#### PROPOSAL & DISCUSSION:

At this time, based on the request of the applicant, staff proposes changes to the portions of Chapter 18.55 that expressly or impliedly prohibit outdoor commercial cannabis cultivation.

Specifically, this involves adding language to Section 18.55.070(C)(15) which requires ventilation and exhaust, implying that all operations must occur within a building, and Section 18.55.070(C)(16), which expressly states that all commercial cannabis activities must occur entirely within a building.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

If approved, this ordinance amendment would allow the City Council to consider approval of outdoor cultivation subject to a regulatory permit.

#### **Environmental**

The first step in complying with CEQA is to determine whether the activity in question constitutes a "project" as defined by CEQA, Public Resources Code Section 21000, et seq. and the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations Section 15000, et seq. A "project" consists of the whole of an action (i.e., not the individual pieces or components) that may have a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect effect on the environment. The second step is to determine whether the project is subject to or exempt from the statute. This proposal qualifies as a project under CEQA because it involves an amendment to the zoning ordinance, which expressly falls within the definition of "project" in CEQA Guidelines Section 15378. Further, the whole of the action includes development of the site with a commercial cannabis facility. At the time the original regulatory permit was approved, the City Council made a determination pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15183(a), which is based upon Public Resources Code Section 21083.3, and which provides statutory exemption from CEQA for projects meeting the required criteria:

"(a) CEQA mandates that projects which are consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are particular to the project or its site. This streamlines the review of such projects and reduces the need to prepare repetitive environmental studies."

Prior to adoption of the 2010 General Plan Update, the City Council certified the Final Environmental Impact Report prepared in conjunction with the General Plan Update. The EIR identified, analyzed, and proposed all feasible mitigation to reduce potentially significant environmental impacts to less than significant levels, unless said impacts were unable to feasibly be so mitigated. The City Council made findings and adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations indicating that, although adoption and implementation of the General Plan could result in significant and unavoidable impacts, the benefits of the General Plan outweighed these impacts.

For the subject project, staff prepared an environmental checklist, the intention of which was to examine environmental effects that might be project specific or otherwise peculiar to the site. None were identified. Thus, given that the proposed project is consistent with and serves to implement the General Plan for which an EIR was certified, and analysis of the project did not identify any peculiar circumstances that could result in a significant environmental effect, staff recommends a finding that the proposed action is not subject to any additional environmental review, and is statutorily exempt from CEQA under Public Resources Code Section 21083.3(b).

The above determination would also accommodate the proposed text amendment, which itself is intended to help implement the General Plan.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

The application to amend the zoning text is paid for by application fees.

(CDBG-CV2 and CV3) NOFA DATED DECEMBER 18, 2020

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The California Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) is pleased to announce the availability of approximately \$5.9 million of unclaimed funds from tranche one, and \$54.4 million of new funds from tranche two and \$16.8 million from tranche three of new federal funds for the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Relief (CDBG-CV) available for local assistance. Funding for this Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) is made available pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act signed into law March 27, 2020.

The primary federal objective of the CDBG program is the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and through expanding economic opportunities, principally, for persons of low- and moderate-income. "Persons of low and moderate income" are defined as families, households, and individuals whose incomes do not exceed 80 percent of the county median income, adjusted for family or household size. # REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL

SUBJECT: Purchase new patrol rifles to replace outdated rifles.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff request City Council approve recommendation to purchase new patrol rifles to assist officers in protecting the community from violent armed offenders and in cases where student lives are threatened by active shooters. Patrol rifles are standard issue department equipment found in all police agencies nationwide.

Remaining funds are available in professional services of the Parlier Police Department 2020-21 F/Y budget

**BACKGROUND:** The Parlier Police department's patrol rifles are Colt M16-A1 first produced in 1963 and are the first generation of four generations. The rifles were acquired through a U.S. military surplus program with an unaccounted amount of ammunition fired through them.

These rifles are outdated, big and bulky, which makes them difficult to maneuver in close quarters and in many shooting situations. Due to the obsolete design of these rifles they are difficult to upgrade with shoulder slings, optics and night lights, which assist officers in accuracy and identifying targets.

We have recently experienced charging malfunctions with these weapons as a result of worn-out mechanical components, which are expensive and not conveniently available.

Investing in newer rifles, not only improves firearm operational reliability but attributes to increased officer safety, and is fiscally beneficial by way of reduced costs for parts and upgrades. Officers frequently mitigate various volatile situations during vehicle stops, search warrants, armed robberies and gang sweeps which make them vulnerable to gun fire. Because high powered assault rifles are a common weapons in the repertoire of gang members and drug dealers, officers will be at a disadvantage.

The current rifles we are looking into getting will be compatible with the ammunition we currently have in stock. The rifles will also be of shorter length allowing a responding officer to maneuver them in a home or apartment compared to what is carried now.

Most important thing will be reliability, these rifles will come with very reliable parts and from a reputable company who will be able to assist us should any trouble arise.

FISCAL IMPACT: Because expenditures for this recommendation meets criteria for open bid, three separate quotes for the repair have been acquired. If approved, staff will execute repairs from quote with least economical impact on the city.
