NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Redistricting is a once a decade process of redrawing the boundaries for City Council districts from which the four City Council members of the City of Parlier are elected. Redistricting occurs after each U.S. Census. At the above time and place, the City Council will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of informing the public about the redistricting process, and how current Census data affect the city council electoral districts, and whether those districts need to change to maintain a rough equality of population within each of the four districts. At the above time and place the City Council will invite and consider comments from the community about what factors should be taken into consideration in creating new district boundaries, on proposals for new boundaries, and other matters relating to the creation of new boundaries. The public is requested to provide input regarding communities of interest and other local factors that should be considered while drafting district maps. A community of interest under the relevant Elections Code for cities (§21601(c) and 21621(c)) is a population that shares common social or economic interests that should be included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation.
