BACKGROUND:
The Parlier Police Department Building Renovation Project goal is to design the exterior and interior building renovation of the existing Police Department building. Dyson & Janzen Architects, Inc will be responsible for all architectural and engineering services necessary to design and complete the Project including, but not limited to, planning, preliminary inspection, design, construction documents, coordination, and approvals. This Project will consist of architectural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and network services.
Proposals were received, opened, and read aloud at 2:00 p.m. on August 24th, 2023. The lowest responsive bid was submitted by Dyson & Janzen Architects, Inc in the amount of \$270,000.00.

- 1. Wishon Aveune, Suite 101, Fresno, CA 93728 in the amount of Two Hundred and Seventy Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$270,000.00);

- 3. The City Manager or Mayor is authorized to sign the City's standard form of contract for construction projects, as contained in the proposal package on behalf of the City of Parlier.

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARLIER ACCEPTING AND APPROVING MAYOR TO SUBMIT AND SIGN CLAIMS FOR MEASURE C ALLOCATION PASSTHROUGH TO THE FRESNO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-24

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Transportation Authority has notified the City of Parlier of the availability of Local Transportation Funds from Measure C for fiscal year 2023-24, and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Transportation Authority is the administrator of the Retail Transactions and Use Tax (1/2 cent) Funds collected pursuant to the Fresno County Transportation Improvement Act as provided by Part 1.6 (commencing with Section 7251) of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code and Public Utilities Code Sections 142000, et seq.,and

WHEREAS, California Public Utilities Code Section 142257 provides that the 2006 Measure C Extension Expenditure Plan, which was approved prior to and provided the basis for the ballot measure considered by the voters at the November 7, 2006, election, shall specify the amount and the formula by which the retail transactions and use tax shall be allocated to each participating jurisdiction for Measure C Extension Program and Project Funds Local Transportation Purposes determined to be priority projects by local governments to which funds are allocated, and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Measure C Extension Expenditure Plan creates a number of transportation programs to be funded by participating jurisdictions with Measure C funds passed through from the Authority to the jurisdiction submitting eligible project claims, and

WHEREAS, these various programs have differing requirements, exemptions, and formulas for calculating pass-through funding levels, and

WHEREAS, this Measure C funding provides services for various transportation and related costs necessary for the City of Parlier, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Parlier agrees to maintain compliance of the Measure C program as required by the Measure C Extension Local Agency Handbook,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Parlier intends to complete and submit the reporting requirements for the prior fiscal years Measure C Extension expenditures no later than November 15, 2022; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Parlier to accept and approve the submittal of the Measure C claims for fiscal year 2021-22, which claims are attached to the Resolution, and the City Council of the City of Parlier further agrees that each subprogram of the Measure C extension funds will be utilized as follows:
